

Hills immunology - Instructions

These instructions assume you have completed registration via the email sent to you from donotreply@echo360.org.au

To access your course login at <https://echo360.org.au>

Click on the **Courses** menu at the top navigation area

Click on **Immunology for Basic Physician Trainees**

You will have a list of recordings/collections available to you in this course

The first collection is called **Before the course....** you must expand the entry by clicking the arrow next to the title.

You can play any recordings that are part of that collection by clicking its title (then clicking the play button).
